Parents of children ages 5, who have completed kindergarten, through age 14 may apply for scholarships by completing this application and providing the following information:

1. Social Security card for child (may use income tax return or school records)
2. Proof of **ALL** household income for the last 30 days: Pay Stubs, Child Support Income, TANF, Social Security Income, and/or Food Stamp eligibility letter which indicates proof of income (must be dated within last 90 days.) Note: Eligibility cannot be determined without proof of income.

Summer Recreation Programs for Children with special needs

Summer Camp is available for children with special needs at Edgewater Public School in Edgewater, and Volusia Pines Elementary School in Lake Helen. To qualify, the child must have multi variable exceptionalities and have medical clearance. The child must be able to work within a 1:5 teacher ratio.
